Mole Trapping 101

We have supplied you with four mole traps in this kit. There are two completely different designs for different situations. These traps are the best on the market in terms of quality and effectiveness and with a little practice you will be catching your own moles in no time.

Mole Behavior

Despite what most people think, moles do not eat your bulbs or roots of your grass. Moles are carnivorous and make a mess of your yard or property in search of meat. They have high metabolism and must feed often on grubs, earthworms, and night crawlers. People also think well if I spray my yard for grubs, the food source will go away, and so will the moles. As easy as that sounds, professional research and our own research shows that spraying for grubs doesn't help much. Moles are going to traverse your yard in search of food, and worms like moist soil. So when the ground is soft, the moles will be higher up near the surface and when it's dry they will be deeper in search of food. That is why we chose to offer two different style traps. The trap in Figure 1 shows an ideal trap for the shallow runs and when the moles are active near the surface. The trap shown in Figure 3 is for the deep runs, when you find mole mounds or deep runs in your yard. These mounds are created when the moles dig deeper, so the dirt has to go somewhere in you find them scattered across the yard. See Figure 2 below for mole mound identification.
